Injury to wheelchair user and other passengers	4	2	8	Wheelchairs must use ramp and secured correctly with purpose made straps and attachments
Passengers knocked or bruised from being bumped about	3	2	6	Passengers advised to lean forward slightly if it gets very bumpy as surface might make it uncomfortable. Land Rover to travel very slowly.
Falling when getting on and off the trailer	3	1	3	Passengers get on/off only once steps have been pulled out and fixed securely. One adult to sit at the back next to the door.
