Knocked down by car	5	1	5	Parents to drive carefully through yard to car park, then walk children across to classroom - children not to be unattended when going to toilet block. Adult to stand by toilet block door if cars are entering or leaving car park.
Injuring from farm vehicles	5	1	5	Children instructed to stay close to adults. Farm workers informed of visit
Uneven/slippery ground - falling	2	3	6	Wear wellies with grip. Instructed to pay attention where they are walking, no running. Follow adults instructions
Injury to eyes from loose straw	3	1	3	Children told to sprinkle low on the ground rather than throwing
Dry Stone Walls collapsing	5	1	5	Instructed not to touch walls
Cows – charging	5	1	5	Not to go into animal pens
Infections, such as EColi	5	1	5	Not to touch animals/ animal housing unless instructed to. Children told not to put hands near mouth. Children to be supplied with gloves to help reduce risk of them putting their fingers in mouths. Wash hands before eating/drinking & leaving. Adults to be supplied with gel to use if needed on the tour. Wellies to be washed before leaving farm & children to change into clean shoes before leaving. Not to put mouths near bars in parlour
Drowning in slurry storage	5	1	5	Will not go near entrance, children informed to stay by adult
Falling from stationary farm vehicle	4	2	8	Adult to assist one child at a time to get into and get out of vehicle. Vehicle engine off.
Feeding silage	5	1	5	Children to space out so they don't knock each other with shovels/brushes. Adults to assist
